Meeting Scrutiny of the Case for Prioritising a Bypass for Lyndhurst A letter had been received from HCC Councillor Peter Hutcheson, Chairman of the Environment and Transportation Policy Review Committee stating that HCC is launching a scrutiny review of the case for prioritising a bypass for Lyndhurst. The style of the review is that it should be led by evidence provided by a range of interested stakeholders. Lyndhurst Parish Council had been invited to take part by submitting their views on three key questions:-

- (1) What are the current traffic problems and highways issues in Lyndhurst?
- (2) What are the possible solutions to these problems?
- (3) Of the range of possible solutions, would a bypass be a viable and deliverable option?

A response was requested by 12 October 2007.

**RESOLVED:** That a pack be made up containing all relevant documents and that Mr Charlesworth, Professor Barber and Mr Woolley arrange to hold a meeting to formalise the Parish Council reply.
